
SPECIFIC FACILITIES PROVIDED FOR WOMEN FOR THE LAST FIVE YEARS

Specific facilities provided for women in terms of:

- 1. Safety and security -the institute has taken the following safety & security measures:
- a. CCTV the institution has high-quality CCTV cameras installed in the college to track the activity of every student and staff and visitors, thus ensuring their safety inside the campus.



b. Student grievances redressal cell and anti-ragging cell - The Institution has a special cell called student grievances redressal cell (SGRC) and an anti-ragging cell through which it addresses the student's grievances related to academic and non-academic matters, such as assessment, victimization, harassment by colleague students or teachers, etc.



c. Security and Inquiry at Main Entrance of the Campus - Adequate security forces are available in the college 24/7 throughout the campus and also in the hostel who make sure that no untoward incident takes place on the campus.









d. Fire Extinguisher – Fire Extinguisher is very essential where student's gatherings are large. To avoid damage to the equipment and to the furniture, the institution have placed firefighting equipment at all the places where large gatherings are expected.





2. Counselling – A well-defined mentoring system practiced in the Institution. In this system, each faculty will be a mentor for a group of 20-25 students. These faculties will continue to be mentors for the same group of students till their graduation.

Responsibilities of the mentor:

- 1. Mentor meeting will be conducted at least 4-5 times every year
- 2. Students will be continuously monitored and counselled in all aspects of academic matters including health issues.
- 3. Contact parents/guardians if the situation demands e.g., academic irregularities, negative behavioral changes, and interpersonal relations, detrimental activities, health issues, etc.
- 4. Maintain a detailed progressive record of the student.
- 5. Maintain a brief but clear record of all discussions with students.



3. Common Rooms – The Institution provides a common room that is effectively used by all students and staff members. It provides a quiet and relaxing environment when they are sick. It includes washrooms, table and chairs.
